### UNRESTRICTED GIFTS

---

### CAMP IMAGINATION

---



This two-week summer arts camp for 100 first – twelfth graders is held for two sessions every June. Since 2002, Camp has stretched the imagination of children by introducing them to a variety of arts genres through an intensive hands-on program of activities that integrates technical, visual and performing arts mediums.

Local and nationwide teaching artists engage kids in a variety of arts classes targeted to different skill levels. Campers in lead roles meet intensively with acting, dancing and singing coaches to learn advanced performance techniques and skills. The second week of camp culminates in a live, public performance which stars all of the campers, either on stage or behind the scenes as the technical and film crews.

### “MADE IN WICKENBURG” ARTIST RESIDENCY PROGRAM

---

Launched in 2009, the Webb Center's nationally recognized artist residency program invites an artistic company to live at a guest ranch in Wickenburg while developing a new piece of work. Companies chosen for the project have included Bill T. Jones Dance, Jessica Lang Dance, Steven Petronio Dance, the Joe Goode Performance Group, and American Ballet Theater II.

The choreographers offer free, Open Rehearsals to educate the public on their art form and creative process; and participate in our “Conversation with the Artist” program, which gives our donors exclusive insight into their artistic careers. Past work toured nationally and internationally, with the “Made in Wickenburg” designation.
