Mainstage Camp is for students who are beginning grades 7-12 in the coming 2017-2018 school year.

Classes are offered on a first to enroll basis. Classes must have a minimum of 5 students enrolled to be officially offered and many classes have a maximum enrollment.

- SHOWTIME!** - Camp Imagination is a performing arts camp culminating in a live performance of *Happily Ever After...* Mainstage campers who wish to appear in the production as a member of the ensemble should select this class and electives below. During this class the campers will learn the songs, movements and acting skills related to the performance. **All campers EXCEPT those enrolled in The Cutting Room and Technical Theatre classes must participate in this class.**

Each student will enroll in an additional 3 elective arts classes, with the fourth - seventh choices as alternates. Please select your top 7 preferences using numbers **1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7**. Indicate your choices in the boxes below.

- Dance to the Beat of Your Own Drum** – Experience the joy of music while playing the rhythms of Africa and other cultures. Mr. Three Trees will guide you on a journey of awakening the drummer inside you. Also build, decorate and learn how to play your very own Australian Didgeridoo, the world's oldest wind instrument.
- Bell of the Ball** – Learn how to play the hand bells, read music and perform songs in this introductory class with Miss Brownie
- Let's Play in the Mud!** – Get down and dirty as students learn about clay, ceramic making techniques, and painting with colorful glazes. After firing in the kiln, students will take home 1-3 finished pieces. Presented by the Desert Caballeros Western Museum.
- Just Keep Painting** – Explore different visual arts mediums including watercolor painting, calligraphy and colored pencil drawing. Presented by the Desert Caballeros Western Museum.
- Comedy Improv** - Learn how to develop and use your own unique energy, establish a group mind, and create characters physically and emotionally in scenes. Remember: Acting is Reacting!
- Aerial Circus** - Fly on the aerial silks. Climb & swing in this fun aerial circus arts class! *Special requirements: Tight-fitting, short sleeve shirts must be worn, no short shorts or skirts are allowed, and eye-glasses must be removed prior to using the equipment.*

- Move Like the Flash!** - Learn soccer fundamentals, speed training and efficient movement on the playing field with Coach Abe.
- Dragon Warrior Training** – Learn Kung Fu martial arts and self-defense in a safe environment.

- Costume Design & Construction** - Students will sketch and create costume designs based on their favorite characters. Students will learn basic costume construction to produce their own take-home projects, including fabric selection, sewing, following patterns, and stitching techniques.

Please choose Film Production below or other electives above.***
- The Cutting Room** - Learn digital photo and video techniques with Sam Erdmann. Create and edit your own video. ***These students will not be on stage performing in Happily Ever After... but will be operating important behind-the-scenes equipment as Stage Hands. Please choose Film Production below or other electives above.***
- Film Production** - You will script, act, film, and direct the daily "Camp Imagination News" with Sam Erdmann. *Students who choose Film Production and wish to be on stage during the performance of Happily Ever After... should select the Showtime class and additional electives above. Students who select Film Production and wish to work backstage during the performance of Happily Ever After... should choose either the Technical Theatre or The Cutting Room class above.*
